Terms and Conditions for Exhibitors

- 1. Vendors are solely responsible for their exhibit material's arrival and return. Ideally, items should be shipped directly to your representative for them to hand carry to the meeting. <u>Liability</u>: Campus personnel will be on duty, but the Exhibit area may not be completely locked after exhibits close.
